A red star marks our new public boating facility that provides storage lockers, restrooms and showers, laundry, vending machines, and a lounge with charts and WiFi Internet access. The adjacent Ann Street Pier offers public dockage for vessels up to 40 feet, a dinghy dock, pumpout facility, and trash disposal. The Harbor Shuttle stops here, too. 401-845-5816, VHF 09.
